Children 6 months—18 years (shot or mist) \$7.00\*

Adults 19 years and older \$15.00\*

## Pneumonia Vaccine

High risk groups ages 2—18 \$7.00\*

High risk groups ages 19—64 and all adults 65 years and older \$15.00

*\* The above fees are based on a sliding fee scale that could reduce the cost to \$0*

*A \$10.00 additional fee for individuals who do not live, work to go to school in the Health District.*

## Who should get influenza vaccine?

- All children 6 months and older and all older adults.
  - Anyone 50 years of age or older.
- Anyone who is at risk of complications from influenza, or more likely to require medical care:
- Women who will be pregnant during influenza season.
  - Anyone with long-term health problems.
  - Anyone with a weakened immune system.
  - Anyone with certain muscle or nerve disorders.
  - Anyone 6 months through 18 years of age on long-term aspirin treatment.
  - Residents of nursing home and other chronic-care facilities.

Anyone who lives with or cares for people at high risk for influenza-related complications:

- Health care providers.
- Household contacts and caregivers of children from birth up to 5 years of age.
- Household contacts and caregivers of
  - people 50 years and older, or
  - anyone with medical conditions that put them at higher risk for severe complications from influenza.

Health care providers may also recommend a yearly influenza vaccination for:

- People who provide essential community services.
- People living in dormitories, correctional facilities, or under other crowded conditions, to prevent outbreaks.
- People at high risk of influenza complications who travel to the Southern hemisphere between April and September, or to the tropics or in organized tourist groups at any time.

*Influenza vaccine is also recommended for anyone who wants to reduce the likelihood of becoming ill with influenza or spreading influenza to others.*
