Children 6 months—18 years (shot or mist) \$7.00*

Adults 19 years and older \$18.00*

Pneumonia Vaccine

High risk groups ages 2—18 \$7.00*

High risk groups ages 19—64 and all adults 65 years and older \$15.00*

** The above fees are based on a sliding fee scale that could reduce the cost to \$0*

A \$10.00 additional fee for individuals who do not live, work or go to school in the Health District.

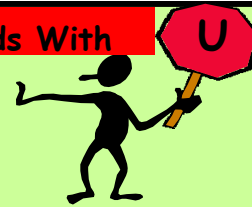

Who should get influenza vaccine?

On February 24, 2010

The Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices recommended "universal" flu vaccination in the U.S. so that **EVERYONE** 6 months and older gets a flu vaccine this fall. In order to reduce the likelihood of becoming ill with flu or spreading flu to others.

Who should get Pneumonia vaccine?

Pneumococcal disease can be associated with viral illnesses such as influenza and can lead to serious infections of the lungs (pneumonia), blood (bacteremia), and covering of the brain (meningitis).

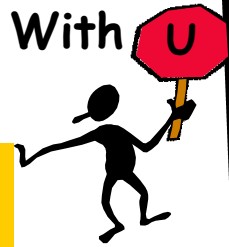
- All adults 65 years of age and older should receive a pneumonia shot. These adults only need one pneumonia shot to protect them for their lifetime.
- Adults needing 2 shots in their lifetime are any adult 19 years through 64 years of age who has any of the following:
 - Heart or lung disease
 - Diabetes
 - Weakened immunity
 - Is a smoker
 - Asthma
 - Alcoholism

These adults will need a booster 5 years after the first shot. The maximum is 2 shots in your lifetime.

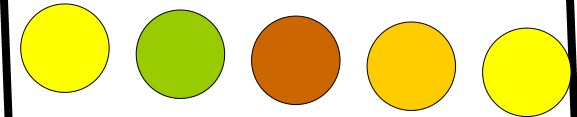
- Children over 2 with a chronic disease or health condition may also need a pneumonia shot—check with child's healthcare provider.
