DELAWARE, Oh., Dec. 27, 2011 – Keep Delaware County Beautiful asks community recycling bin users to report overflows by phoning 740-203-2076.

Rumpke Recycling crews have been emptying Delaware County’s recycling dropoff bins as quickly as possible since Christmas. The work has been slowed because bins have been stuffed full and hand pickup was required for items illegally deposited outside the bins.

Keep Delaware County Beautiful Coordinator Jenifer Way-Young said the bins are being serviced as quickly as possible. She asks users who find full bins to be patient and either return at a later time or use a recycling bin at another location. A list of bin locations is posted at www.delawarehealth.org/litter.
