DELAWARE, Oh., Jan. 8, 2010 – The Delaware General Health District is adding a monthly child immunization clinic at the Genoa Township Hall.

Starting Jan. 20, child immunizations will be available from 2 to 4 p.m. on the third Wednesday of each month at the Genoa Township Hall, 5111 S. Old 3C Highway, Westerville. Residents can reserve appointments for child immunizations during those hours by phoning 740-203-2040. Walk-ins also are welcome.

Genoa Township was added as a child immunization site as part of the Health District's ongoing efforts to raise immunization rates and make services more convenient for residents. The Genoa clinics will be in addition to the child immunization clinics offered regularly at the Health District clinic in Delaware and monthly at the Sunbury United Methodist Church.
