DELAWARE, Oh., Jan. 6, 2010 – The Delaware General Health District will start offering H1N1 immunizations at its downtown Delaware facility this week, and is adopting a recurring weekly schedule for H1N1 clinics.

Appointments, which clients can self-schedule online, will still be required.

Starting Thursday, the H1N1 immunizations will be offered at the Adult Walk-In Clinics held every weekday from 7:30 to 9 a.m. at the Health District Clinic, 3 W. Winter St., Delaware.

The Health District also will continue H1N1 immunization clinics at the Delaware Health Center, 801 Ohio Health Boulevard. Starting next week, those will be every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:30 to 6:30 p.m. Those clinics will be equipped to immunize up to 25 clients in every 15-minute schedule block.

Another H1N1 immunization clinic at the Delaware Health Center is scheduled for Saturday, Jan. 23, from 9:15 to 11:45 a.m. Additional weekend clinics will be announced.

The immunizations are free and available to everyone ages six months and older. To schedule an appointment, visit www.delawarehealth.org and follow the link and instructions. Persons without internet access can schedule by phoning the Health District at 740-368-1700. The clinics can serve up to 25 clients in every 15-minute block on the schedule, and the average waiting time is less than 10 minutes.
