DELAWARE, Oh., Feb. 19, 2010 – Free H1N1 immunizations will be available at The Columbus Zoo on Wednesday, Feb. 24.

The H1N1 immunizations will be available at the Zoo Activity Pavilion from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. People wanting H1N1 immunizations will be admitted to the Zoo for free and get free parking. The immunizations will be given by the Delaware General Health District, and are available for zoo patrons and employees. No appointments are needed.

Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and have consent forms signed by a parent to receive the immunizations. Consent forms can be downloaded from www.delawarehealth.org.

H1N1 immunizations also are available by appointment at the Delaware General Health District clinic, 3 W. Winter St., Delaware, weekday mornings from 7:45 to 9 a.m. Another appointments-only clinic is scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 27, from 9:15 to 11:45 a.m. at the Delaware Health Center, 801 OhioHealth Boulevard, Delaware.
