FREE Car Seats & Booster Seats

The Delaware Public Health District will provide a new car/booster seat to eligible parents and caregivers.

To qualify for a FREE seat you must:

- Be a Delaware Public Health District resident
- Be the child's legal guardian
- Attend a child passenger safety class with a certified technician
- Be eligible for financial assistance

STAGES OF CAR SEAT USE: BEST PRACTICE

Based on the American Academy of Pediatrics Recommendations

STAGE 1

BIRTH TO 3 YEARS

REAR-FACING ONLY



STAGE 2

4 TO 7 YEARS

FORWARD-FACING WITH HARNESS



STAGE 3

8 TO 12 YEARS

BOOSTER SEAT



STAGE 4

AGE 13 YEARS AND OLDER

LAP & SHOULDER BELT



A safe car/booster seat is one that is appropriate for your child's height, weight, maturity and developmental stage. The law requires **ONLY** the minimum standard for your child's safety.
