

- 22/30 overdoses included more than one drug
- 80% of the overdose deaths included fentanyl
- Delaware County has a 3.4% positivity rate for non-prescribed fentanyl when drug specimens are tested in a lab
- There were no xylazine overdose deaths recorded in the County in 2022




NUMBER OF RESIDENT DEATHS INVOLVING SELECT SUBSTANCES

DELAWARE COUNTY EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT VISITS FOR SUSPECTED DRUG OVERDOSE BY AGE GROUP

- The group with the highest amount of ER visits with suspected overdoses were individuals 15-34 years old.
- There was a total of 278 ER visits of Delaware County individuals for suspected drug overdose.
- 51% of ER visits were individuals aged 15-34 years old.
- 81% of individuals were white.



IN 2022, THE DELAWARE PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT:

• DPHD distributed 529 individual Project DAWN kits.



• DPHD has trained 404 individuals in Project DAWN opioid education and naloxone distribution.

DPHD has distributed **154** First Responders kits to Law Enforcement and security personnel in Delaware County. There were **17** overdose reversals by Delaware County First Responders in 2022.*
