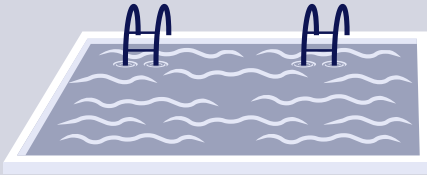




UNDERSTANDING THE PUBLIC POOL & SPA INJURY INCIDENT REPORT FORM

INJURIES AT PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS:



An estimated **140,000 injuries** associated with swimming activities occur each year.



WHEN TO REPORT

- The Public Pool & Spa Injury Incident Report Form is to be completed after any incident that occurs within the pool perimeter that results in:
 - Death
 - Serious injury
 - Assistance from emergency medical personnel
 - Illness involving more than one person
- The Public Pool & Spa Injury Incident Report Form is to be reported to the licenser **within 72 hours following the incident** or when the licensee becomes aware of the incident.



WHAT TO REPORT

- Facility information.
- Description of an injured person. **DO NOT** include personal information (e.g.,
 - Name, address, phone number etc.).
- Description of incident
 - Incident location, date, and time
 - General description of what happened
 - Result of incident
 - Type of injury and injury area
