



Alternative Loading Rates for Hydraulic Linear Loading Rate (HLLR) Agreement

Per the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-29, any alternative method for determining the Hydraulic Linear Loading Rate (HLLR) shall be detailed in the system design with approval by the board of health. The Delaware Public Health District (DPHD) favors the use of the standard OAC 3701-29-15 loading rates when applicable. Alternative loading rates shall only be considered when the aforementioned loading rates are not viable.
