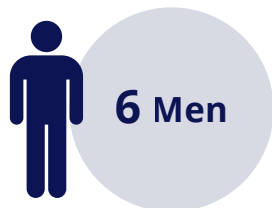

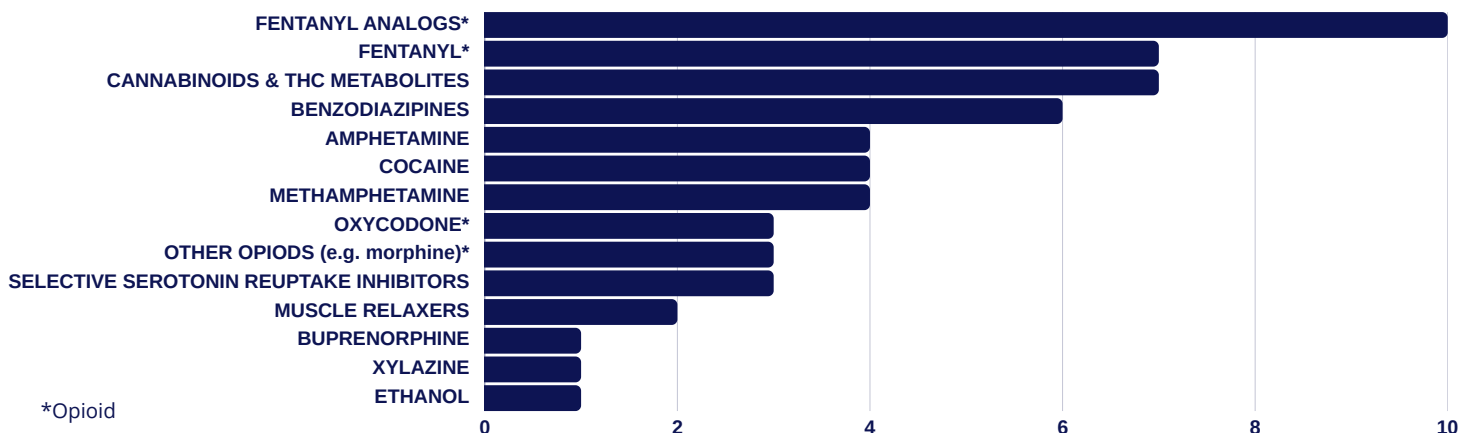

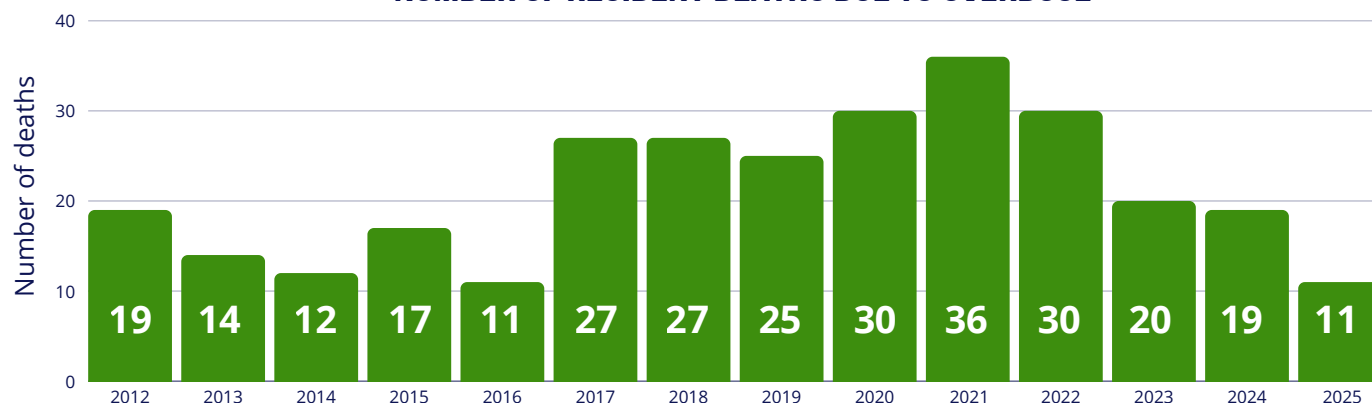

DELAWARE COUNTY EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT (ED) VISITS FOR SUSPECTED DRUG OVERDOSE*



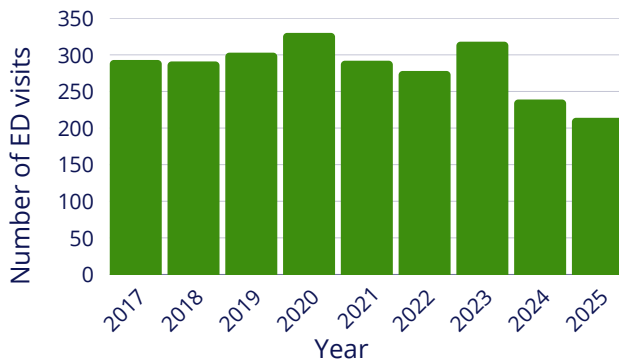

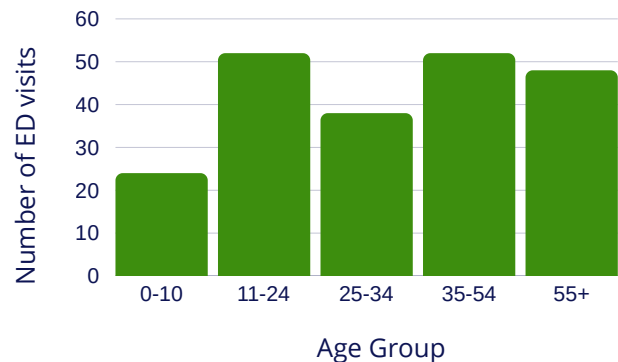

There was a total of **214 ED** visits of Delaware County individuals for suspected drug overdose in 2025, a decrease from the prior year.

The groups with the highest amount of ED visits with suspected overdoses were individuals **11-24** and **35-54** years old, followed by individuals 55+ years old.

NALOXONE DISTRIBUTION

- Distributed **906** individual naloxone kits.
- Distributed **247** First Responders kits to law enforcement and security personnel.
- Provided naloxone in **118** first-aid kits, AED kits, and Naloxboxes.
- **Two** outdoor naloxone cabinets were installed at Safe Harbor Peer Support Services and Concord Township Park to increase community access to naloxone.
- Since July 2025, over **300** naloxone kits have been distributed in the community from the 24/7 Naloxone Vending Machine located in the lobby of the Delaware County Jail.
